2. WHAT ARE COOKIES

Cookies are small text files that POOL Website places and stores on your device used for accessing this POOL Website. They are generally needed to ensure operation of our POOL Website. They may also help to analyze how our POOL Website is used.

3. TYPES OF COOKIES USED, PURPOSES OF THEIR USE AND RETENTION PERIODS

On this POOL Website we use only necessary and statistics cookies. Necessary cookies are those we need to ensure proper functioning of this POOL Website, while statistics cookies help us to understand how users interact with our POOL Website by collecting and reporting information anonymously.

Cookies are stored on your respective device and transmitted to our web server. However, there is a distinction between so-called permanent cookies and session cookies. Session cookies are stored during a sole browser session and are deleted when the browser is closed. Permanent cookies are not deleted when the respective browser session is closed but are stored on the user's end device for a longer period of time.

Below we have specified the list of cookies we use, types of such cookies, purpose of their use, and their corresponding retention periods:

4. LEGAL BASES

4.1. Necessary cookies

The law allows us to store cookies on your device if they are strictly necessary for the operation of this site and marked "necessary" in the above table. Legal bases in such a case may be as follows:

- Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 lit. (b) GDPR (contractual necessity) to the extent use of cookies is necessary to ensure proper functioning of POOL Website and (or) POOL App and your use of the same under the Terms and Conditions;
- Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 lit. (c) GDPR (legal obligation) where we need to use cookies to comply with our legal obligation (for example, to confirm that we have obtained your consent to use cookies);
- Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 lit. (f) GDPR (legitimate interest) since proper functioning of POOL Website is our legitimate interest.

4.2. Other cookies

Where we use cookies, which are not necessary, we need your corresponding consent according to Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 lit. (f) GDPR. We will request such consent with use of a consent tool demonstrated to you once visit our website.

5. COOKIES MANAGEMENT

As a user, you have full control over the use and storage of cookies. In particular you may control use of cookies by the following ways:

5.1. Cookie banner

You can manage your cookie preferences using a cookie consent tool on our POOL Website. Specifically, you may allow us to use all cookies, only necessary cookies and, optionally, advertising cookies. We, again, draw your attention that you may not opt-out from our use of necessary cookies.

5.2. Browser settings

By changing the settings in your Internet browser, you can generally deactivate or restrict the transmission of cookies. You can delete cookies that have already been saved at any time. This can also be done automatically. If all cookies are deactivated for our POOL Website, it may no longer be possible to use all the functions of the website to their full extent.

6. GOOGLE ANALYTICS

We use Google Analytics, a web analysis service provided by Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheater Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA, (Google). Google Analytics uses a tracking cookie to recognize a user who has visited our website in the past (see section 2 above). The information collected by the cookie about your use of our POOL Website (including your IP address) is usually transmitted to a Google server in the USA and stored there.

We added the code "gat._anonymizelp();" to Google Analytics, so your IP address (the number that your Internet access provider has assigned to your device) will be shortened beforehand by Google at our request within member states of the European Union or in other contracting states of the Agreement on the European Economic Area. The usage profiles generated by Google Analytics are thus anonymized, which means that it is impossible to draw conclusions about a specific person. Only in exceptional cases will the full IP address be sent to a Google server in the USA and shortened there.

The usage profiles contain, for example, information about length of stay, approximate geographic origin, origin of visitor traffic, exit pages and usage processes. Google will use this information to evaluate your use of our website, to compile reports on POOL Website activity for us and to provide us with other services related to POOL Website and Internet use. We delete the anonymous usage profiles recorded by Google after twelve (12) months.
